Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

Brief Details:

Car 5 made initial contact with the rear of car 23 in the braking zone of T2 causing car 23 to lose control. As the cars proceeded around T3 it was clear because of the contact at T2 car 5 had gained an unfair advantage on the inside of car 23. Secondary contact was made between the two cars in which I believe car 5 straightened and made contact with the rear right of car 23 causing car 23 to leave the circuit.

Evidence Relied Upon:

Onboard footage of cars 23, 5 and two evidence cars viewed and the drivers of cars 5 & 23 gave verbal evidence in the judicial hearing.

Accordingly, under NCR Ch.5a App.5 Art.2.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Position Penalty to be applied to this race result.

Additional Comments: As a result car 5 is to serve a 7 place penalty in the race
