Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

## **Brief Details:**

Front right of car 4 made contact with rear left of car 88 as the cars were approaching Turn 4.  
Car 4 had greater speed exiting turn 3 and moved to left to overtake car 88, 88 meanwhile was moving to left of track to defend the position.  
Contact is made in rear quarter of car 88 with 88 then spinning, with multiple rolls. The contact in the opinion of the clerk of the course is minor, but the driver of 4 could have relinquished the opportunity to pass at this point when 88 moved to defend.

Accordingly, under NCR Ch.5a App.5 Art.2.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Number of Licence Penalty Points: 2

Additional Comments: Severity of penalty in line with the nature of the contact in isolation and does not take into consideration any aftermath.

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with the NCR.
