Right of Review hearing conducted at Oulton Park, 15/07/2023 - 09:18

Present: J Murphy (Driver, car 3), A Roberts (Clerk of the Course)

The driver of car 3 (J Murphy) presented video evidence by email from car 44 (Paul Mason) for review that was not available at the time the original decision (dated 25/06/2023, time 18:01). I accepted that this evidence was new and the granting of a right of review hearing was given.

The content of the video was reviewed by both with discussion of the events leading to the incident between 3 and 133, involved car 133 (Richard Higgins) and car 31 (Garath Buckingham) regarding general conduct of car 133 approaching Turn 6 (Rocket In).

The contact between car 3 and 133 occurred at Turn 8 (Rocket Out) with video footage showing front of car 3 making contact with rear of 133. Car 133 spun. Car 3 continued gaining position.

J Murphy stated that the video shows him moving off circuit to avoid collision as 133 had 'chopped across the front of him'.

On review of this new evidence and having an interview with J Murphy, it is my view that J Murphy could have done more to avoid this collision by backing off the accelerator and tucking in behind rather than taking to the grass.

Original decision (dated 25/06/2023, time 18:01) issued at Anglesey to remain unamended.
