Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

H32.1.4 Refusal to obey the instructions of an authorised Official of the meeting.

Brief Details:

Chief Assembly marshal report received, driver interviewed and video footage reviewed.

The driver of car 12 confirmed he had been held in position by the Chief Assembly marshal because he was not fully dressed, with gloves still to go on. The driver of car 12 then claimed they heard someone shout 'go, go'. Car 12 then set off at speed in an unsafe manner, with officials and personnel both next to the car and in clear view in front of the car, whilst still not wearing gloves. Car 12 then came to a stop after being signalled to do so by another assembly marshal.
