

Bulletin No 02

The following change is to be made to the official regulations already published for the British Superkart Grand Prix and in accordance with Motorsport UK general regulation D11.2. This change is to be implemented immediately.

Reason: Clarification.

Revised Regulation:

4.4 Tyres

4.4.2 Two sets of race slick tyres (“race tyres”) and two sets of wets (“wets”) may be **registered**/purchased for the meeting:

4.4.2.1 These sets of race tyres are the only sets permitted for use during Timed Qualifying and Races.

(i) If the session is declared wet only registered wets may be used;


(ii) Only new or the drivers previously marked 2021 British Superkart Championship race tyres may be ~~used~~ **registered**.

(iii) Only with the authority of the Chief Scrutineer, and on the grounds of safety, may a driver be permitted to have replacement tyre(s) recorded for use at the meeting.

4.4.2.2 For Free Practice tyres are open.

To clarify:

- Tyres for use in **Timed Qualifying, Heats and the Final must be registered for the meeting** and will be marked by the meeting officials in the designated Tyre Marking area.
(The tyre supplier will be providing a list of drivers who have purchased tyres to the tyre marking officials, if you are not on the list you will be asked to provide your proof of purchase.)
- For **Practice tyres are free**.
- A driver is permitted to **register 2 sets** of slicks and 2 sets of wets **for the meeting**;
 - The **slick tyres** must have been purchased for the meeting or have been a previously marked tyre at a 2021 British Superkart Championship meeting;
 - **2 sets of wets**, Hoosier W3 Wet or Dunlop KT14 Wet may be registered. **These wets need not have been specifically purchased for the meeting.**
- Wet tyres must be used if the session is declared ‘wet’
