Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s)

Ch.2 App.1 Art.1.1 - Abusive language or behaviour, physical assault or threat of assault

Brief Details:

The championship coordinator received an email of complaint from a Christopher Torretto relating to foul and abusive language used by the Father of Max Horlor, Duncan Horlor, which was aimed at another competitor who was competing on circuit and within earshot of this competitor's Father, David, whilst spectating the race. The statement also accused the driver of car 36 of later using foul language aimed at Mr Torretto. Under investigation, witness statements were gathered from David Potter, Chris Watson and Joy Scott. Under interview, Duncan Horlor admitted the use of foul language as did Max Horlor later on in the paddock. Later, Duncan Horlor apologised to David and this apology was accepted.

Evidence Relied Upon:

Email received by championship coordinator.
Witness statements gathered as above.
Driver of car 36 and his Father, together with team entrant Peter Felix, interviewed.
Championship Clerk of Course Paul Levitt present supported by a Deputy Clerk of the Course at the event, Rob Lee

Accordingly, under NCR Ch.5a App.5 Art.2.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Disqualified from the event.
