### **Brief Details:**

After being involved in three separate collisions with car 223 (dealt with separately), the driver of car 50 confronted the driver of car 223 in the pit lane. Whilst it is accepted that there was no abusive language or behaviour, physical assault or the threat of such; this was an ugly incident of aggressive behaviour which was captured on the live TV feed.
