Ch.2 App.1 Art.1.13 - Driving in a manner not compatible with general safety

### **Brief Details:**

Craig Feeble No1 Engineer was opening the door of car 214, during a pit stop, to enable a driver change. Car 22 also entering the pit change area made to enter into an area that his pit crew were indicating to him. During a briefing all drivers were told that if the pit space was capable of taking a car then they should not stop but go around and complete another lap before stopping. during this incident contact was made with the left ankle of Craig Feeble. This caused a medical intervention by the circuit doctor with Craig being transported to the medical centre via ambulance. He was later discharged
