Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Championship Regulation(s):

H32.1.3 Failure to attend or arriving late to a mandatory Drivers Briefing/Meeting, where this is required by the SRs, by the Clerk of the Course, or by the Stewards of the Meeting.

### **Brief Details:**

With reference to the earlier decision made by the Clerk of the Course, (Fine £250) for breach of championship regulation CR25, further evidence has come to light. The Team manager had already informed an official that they would be late for the mandatory briefing. The incident is accepted as force majeure. The fine is rescinded.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:
