Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

C1.1.5 Driving in a manner incompatible with general safety, and/or departing from the standard of a reasonably competent driver.

Brief Details:

Reports received of unsafe driving through paddock prior to start of Ginetta GT Championship race 1 by marshals. A review of on board footage shows car 6 appeared to be driving in excess of the 5mph paddock speed limit (Final Instructions 32.1) to the Assembly Area. Upon arrival to Assembly, car 6 was not permitted to the circuit as cars had been released to the grid. Car 6 then proceeded to drive through the paddock to pit lane at in excess of the 5mph speed limit, with several persons including children having to quickly avoid the oncoming car 6.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
