Report received stating that car 151 overtook car 267 at Turn 1 whilst yellow signals were being displayed. drivers of both cars interviewed, onboard footage not provided - live stream did not capture the alleged incident. Upon receiving the post chiefs written report, the number differs from the verbal report. Whilst I think this is a clerical error, I feel i cannot penalise the driver of car 151
