Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q12.21.4 Causing a collision

Brief Details:

Contact between cars 1 and 117 exiting T 1 on Lap 1. It is accepted that the driver of car 1 had to correct the car sliding in the centre of the turn; however with car 117 beside and slightly ahead, the driver of car 1 gave the other driver no room to remain on the circuit which led to the contact, and car 117 spinning off the circuit.

Evidence taken from in car footage from car 1, car 117, and car 17 (following); also marshal's written report.

The penalty reflects the continued amount of contact between cars 1 and 117 all season, with repeated warnings from the Clerk regarding driving standards.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Disqualified from the results of the race.

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
