Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s)

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 - Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

### **Brief Details:**

Side to side contact between car 5 and car 95 at turn 3 causing car 95 to spin and then further unavoidable contact with car 63. Car 5 placed two wheels off the circuit and lost slight control on the dirt, causing the contact.

### **Evidence Relied Upon:**

Driver of car 5 and car 95 were interviewed with their representatives. In car video footage was viewed from car 5, car 95 and car 63.

Accordingly, under NCR Ch.5a App.5 Art.2.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Verbal Warning

Driver of car 5 was given 3 Championship driver behavior points.

You are reminded of your right of appeal.

Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with the NCR.
