Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s)

Ch.12 App.6 Art.3.1 - Failure to complete 3 laps during qualifying/practice (24 month rule)

### **Brief Details:**

Car 14 broke down after half a lap during qualifying, thus completed no laps.

The same car / driver combination completed two and a half laps in the Paid Practice session at the start of the day and will also have a part lap to the grid followed by a green flag lap, prior to race start.

Given the above, and subject to the car being re-scrutineered prior to further track activity, the requirements of Ch.12 App.6 Art.3.1 are met and the driver is permitted to start the race from the back of the grid.
