Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s)

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 - Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

### **Brief Details:**

Approaching Turn 16, car 25 caught 27 approaching T16. 27 moved to left and weaved slightly as evidenced from onboard footage, which made their intention unpredictable to their opponent.  
Car 25 misjudged proximity to braking point of T16 and contact made with rear of 25, having left little margin for error.  
For their part in this incident car 27 is issued this penalty for their slight weaving approaching T16.

### **Evidence Relied Upon:**

Hayfisher TV coverage.  
Onboards of cars 25 and 27.  
Interviews with drivers of cars 25 and 27 with team representatives present.

Accordingly, under NCR Ch.5a App.5 Art.2.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:
