Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Cars 26 and 272 were side by side going down Craner Curves, when car 26 and 272 made contact, causing 272 to run wide on the grass and roll multiple times on contact with the gravel trap on the inside of Old Hairpin.

Video footage from car 272, 26, 92 and 46 viewed along with live stream.

Driver interviewed with Peter Felxi (Team) Hayley Lesley (Parent) present.

I feel that I am unable to attribute responsibility to either driver and treat this as a racing incident with no further action. you are reminded of your right to appeal.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

No Further Action - Having investigated the incident referred to above, and reviewed all available footage, I find that there is insufficient evidence of driving in a matter incompatible with general safety and consider the matter to be a racing incident, and therefore I will take no further action.
