Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s)

Ch.2 App.1 Art.1.13 - Driving in a manner not compatible with general safety

Brief Details:

Car 12 made contact with car 2 at turn 13 on lap 1 causing car 2 to spin.
After the race while driving down a busy pit lane, car 12 overtook several cars by crossing the working line and almost making contact with several volunteer marshals and team members who had to take avoiding action.

Evidence Relied Upon:

Car 12 representative (Ritchie Skeels) was interviewed as driver of car 12 had to leave to catch a flight home. In car video footage was viewed from car 12 for the incident with car 2.
In car video footage was viewed from car 36 to show car 12's dangerous behavior in the pit lane. Written report was also received from the chief pit marshal (Ashley Morton).

Accordingly, under NCR Ch.5a App.5 Art.2.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Disqualified from the event.

You are reminded of your right of appeal.
