Incident between cars 7, 42 and 664 viewed on circuit CCTV. Footage viewed from all cars and drivers interviewed from car 7 and 42.

Contact was made between car 7 and 42 resulting in car 42 spinning and being contacted by car 664, resulting in car 42 and 664 retiring from the race. Car 7 continued.
