Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Section Q Appendix 3 (Safety Car) Failure to comply with Safety Car Regulations

### **Brief Details:**

At turn 13 car 67 made noise to tail contact with car 29 and left the circuit towards the left hand side. When re-joining car 67 was seen to overtake another car whilst the safety car procedure was still in place. Driver and team manager both interviewed, on board video reviewed.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Stop & Go

Additional Comments: Stop go penalty converted to post race time penalty, as per regulation 16.5. The addition of 35 seconds is added to the race time and 1 BWP.
