Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

C1.1.8 Misbehaviour or unfair practice

### **Brief Details:**

This penalty regards a report made to the Clerk of the Course regarding the behaviour of a member of driver Tom Mills' team.

Following the second GB4 race of the weekend, a report was submitted via email reporting inappropriate/offensive language used by Kevin Mills in Parc Fermé towards a driver. This driver was later interviewed, as well as Mr. Mills and the person who submitted the report.

Given the public nature of this confrontation, with drivers/team personnel/officials and members of the public and press all present in the vicinity, I am issuing a £500 fine as a contravention of Motorsport UK regulation C1.1.8.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:
