Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q12.21.4 Causing a collision

### **Brief Details:**

Livestream footage and circuit CCTV footage viewed of contact between car 37 and 51 exiting Turn 6 Stowe on Lap 2. Onboard footage viewed from car 37 and rear footage also viewed from car 73 who was ahead of car 37 and 51. Driver of car 37 interviewed.

Car 37 is behind car 51 going through Turn 6 and then drives off track exiting Turn 6 with the car fully in the run-off area. Car 37 then gets partially alongside car 51 and on rejoining the track makes side to side contact with car 51, causing car 51 to spin off circuit drivers left. Car 37 continued.

I find car 37 fully at fault for the unsafe rejoin which resulted in the collision with car 51.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Disqualified from the results of the race.  
Number of Licence Penalty Points: 4

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
