Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.2 App.1 Art.1.13 Driving in a manner not compatible with general safety

Brief Details:

During Race 2 of GB4, the driver of Car 32, Luke Hilton, was observed from on-board videos driving with no hands on the steering wheel and, on occasion, gesturing to another competitor. The driver with his Guardian (Cliff Dempsey) were interviewed by the Clerk of the Course (David Scott), Deputy Clerk (Jon Provost) and Driving Standards Advisor (Rob Barff). Hilton offered no defence for his actions saying that his actions were due to frustration. Following discussions a number of on board video clips were shown.

Evidence Relied Upon:

On board videos from Car 32

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK NCR Ch.5a App.5 Art.2.1, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Disqualified from the results of Race 2 together with a fine in the sum of £250.
Number of Licence Penalty Points: 4

Additional Comments: The competitor was reminded that he must pay the fine to MSUK within 7 days.

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with NCR Ch.5a App.5 Art.2.3
