Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s)

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 - Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

### **Brief Details:**

On lap 1 at T8, car 5 passed around outside of car 36, and partially alongside car 63.  
Car 63 moved slightly to right whom had car 75 to their left and car 5 subsequently went off track onto apron approaching T9.  
Car 5 then rejoined at apex of T9 making contact with car 63 and 63 into car 8. 8 spun, retiring at end of the lap.  
Driver of car 5 is deemed to be predominantly to blame having rejoined in a manner which caused the collision.

### **Evidence Relied Upon:**

Onboard footage of car 5 and car 36 behind.  
Interview with driver of car 5 with team manager, J Ross.

Accordingly, under NCR Ch.5a App.5 Art.2.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:
