Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s)

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 - Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

Brief Details:

Car 54 was reported to have spun at T16 (Brooklands) on the last lap of the race. On further investigation it became apparent that there was contact between the front wing of Car 87 and the rear tyre of Car 54, with Car 54 suffering a puncture as a result. Car 54 made subsequent contact with Car 76 as result of the initial contact. After considering all of the evidence available I find Car 87 to be at fault for the incident.

Evidence Relied Upon:

Onboard footage from Car 87 and Car 76 and interviewed Car 54, Car 87 and Car 76
