Investigation into contact between cars 14 (Simon Horrobin) and 42 (Gary Miller) at turn 11.

Evidence taken from onboard footage of cars 42, 14 and following car 2, plus an interview with driver of car 14.

On review of on board of car 14, car 42 manoeuvred into gap between car 66 which had overtaken, and 14 following just prior to braking point at turn 11. By filling this space that 14 required for braking and the reducing distance that would occur with reducing speed (concertina effect), 14 made contact with rear of 42.

Reviewing the evidence from on board of car 2 following, it shows car 14 hard on the brakes prior to contact.
