Post Qualifying – Pirelli Award

A set of tyres will be awarded to the Pole Position in each of the below classes at each race this season (applicable to full season entries only).

- GT3 Pro-Am pole
- GT3 Silver pole
- GT4 Pro-Am pole
- GT4 Silver pole

We will require a photo of the pole sitters in each of the categories (GT3, GT4.) Drivers to be available when requested.

Post Race – Podium Procedure

Trophy presentations – Donington Park

- 1st, 2nd, 3rd in GT3 Overall
- 1st, 2nd, 3rd in GT3 Pro-Am
- 1st, 2nd, 3rd in GT4 Overall
- 1st GT4 Pro-Am Winner
- 1st GT4 Am Winner
- Sunoco fastest driver of the weekend

After Race, Podium cars and other selected cars will be directed to the Scrutineering Parc Ferme, at Pit Exit.

GT3 and GT4 Overall Race Winners:

- WINNING CO-DRIVERS MUST GO INTO **PARC FERME** AREA (PIT EXIT) IMMEDIATELY in correct race suit to join the winning driver exiting the car for Live TV interviews. Pirelli caps and masks – both mandatory to wear – will be provided here.

All other podium finishers:

- CO-DRIVERS MUST GO TO **PODIUM AREA** (PADDOCK SIDE OF PARC FERME, BESIDE GARAGE 39 RESTAURANT) immediately in race suits to meet your co-driver. Pirelli caps and masks – both mandatory to wear – will be provided here.

Please note:

- Team members MUST NOT attend or spectate this, and drivers must adhere to social distancing in place, noting the markings / stickers on the ground.
- Trophies and champagne will be laid out on a table at the side of the Podium for drivers to collect
- Driver pairs, one pair at a time will be called forward to collect their trophy and champagne and directed onto the Podium (standing either side of first place, socially distanced) for a Photo.
- Champagne must not be sprayed.
- Trophies and champagne will have been cleaned in advance of the presentation
